Dino Zack provided a presentation on Fluorescent Minerals on Saturday and Sunday to packed audiences and received numerous compliments on his presentation. Sandy Cline, internationally renown soapstone carver from Ontario, Canada, entertained visitors with his carvings, techniques, and provided soapstone for some of the children to carve. Thank you to AJ and friends Mitchell the Dinosaur and his motorized horseshoe crab that entertained and educated both children and adults in the NYS Police building,

There were over 33 vendors in rocks, minerals, fossils, cut stones and jewelry. Demonstrators interacted with the public on fossil cleaning and preparation; tumblers; gem tree creations; cabbing of a variety of stones; viewing of geological specimens through microscopes; identification of fossils and minerals; and answered questions about a variety of geological topics and specimens. Over a 1,000 bags of minerals were washed and went home with the miners. The club also sold over 700 mineral grab bags and ran out on Saturday afternoon.
